

Resident's Bill of Rights

1. Each resident shall have the right to be treated with the same honesty, respect and dignity that he demonstrates toward others.
2. All residents have the right to be visited by relatives and to a clean environment for that visit. Each resident is responsible for doing his share towards accomplishing this right.
3. A resident has the right to reasonable privacy, property and space.
4. All residents have the right to freely choose their reading or listening material so long as the personal choices of the resident do not negatively impact others.
5. Residents have a right to reasonable notice before demands are made on their time so that they may practice prior planning.
6. Residents have the right to have their environment free of loud noises and profanity.
7. Residents have the right to attend as many AA and or NA meetings as they choose other than on nights when there is a meeting at the farm. The farm shall assist in providing transportation where possible.
8. No person shall act in a manner that imposes fear of violence toward a resident. No one should have to live in fear of physical or emotional violence.
9. All residents have an equal right to the resources of the residence and no one shall exhaust more than his just share. Excessive occupation of either the resident phone or the bathroom facilities is antisocial behavior.
